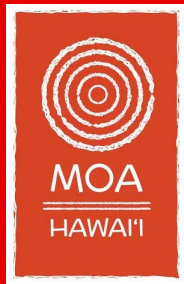

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S MESSAGE

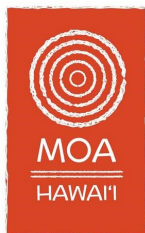
